1) **PRESIDENT CALL MEETING TO ORDER**

Mr. Sherrod called the August 24, 2017, monthly meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. and announced those in attendance.

Meetings are held in the County Extension Offices located in LaBelle, Florida and are open to the public.

2) **ATTORNEY'S REPORT**

a) **EASEMENT ISSUE**

Mr. Sherrod stated that there is no attorney report to present.

3) **OLD BUSINESS**

a) **APPROVE THE DRAFT MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING HELD ON JUNE 22, 2017**

Ms. Clement submitted the draft minutes of the monthly meeting held on June 22, 2017, for the supervisor's review/approval.

Mr. Townsend made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Mr. Giddens seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

4) **ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT**

a) **APPROVE THE FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR JUNE 23, 2017 THROUGH AUGUST 24, 2017**

Ms. Clement submitted the financial reports for approval.

Mr. Townsend made a motion to approve the financial reports as submitted and Mr. Giddens seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

b) **NEXT SCHEDULED MEETING, SEPTEMBER 28, 2017**

Ms. Clement said that the next meeting is to be held on September 28, 2017. Mr. Townsend said that he will not be present at the September 28, 2017, meeting.

5) **ENGINEER'S REPORT**

a) **DESCRIPTIVE DRAWINGS FOR TOWNSEND AND KOZACK, RE:
LATERAL L2-E**

1) Ms. Foster said that she had finally reached Ms. Kozack and that she is fine with her descriptive drawing for Lateral 2-E, and was forwarding it to her attorney for review. Ms. Foster said that she has not heard back from Ms. Kozack.

2) Ms. Foster handed out an amended descriptive drawing for the Townsend group for the Lateral 2-E project, and said that it does indicate a 40 foot width. Mr. Townsend said that he believes there will have to be one small change in the legal description. Mr. Townsend said that the drawing indicates that the district is going to go north along the west line of the said Section 20, and it is needs to be going north along the west line of the southeast quarter of said Section 20. Mr. Townsend said that the description starts out correctly at the south quarter corner, but then it states north along the west line of sub-section 20, and it needs to say the west line of the southeast quarter of said Section 20. Ms. Foster said that she sees the error.

Mr. Townsend said, that the only thing that he has not checked, and he assumes that the engineer has, is the east end of it has to have a 40 foot barring to make sure that it matches his deed.

Mr. Townsend said, as far as the body of the language in the Townsend Group easement, he will send the language of the easement to Mr. Diffenderfer, attorney for CSWCD, and make sure that it is proper. Mr. Townsend said that the easement will have some restrictions, but not to the district and that he will also put language in the easement for D.O.T., and will forward the Kozack's easement to Mr. Diffenderfer.

3) Ms. Foster handed out a descriptive drawing for the Lateral 2E extension easement to all present. Ms. Foster said that she has taken the Kozack easement, and said that she will be doing some more work on it, but stated that this is a typical section. Ms. Foster said that she likes to stay 5 feet off of the property line, and feels that it will be sufficient. Ms. Foster said so the drawing indicates a 40 foot easement and 20 feet for the road. Ms. Foster asked if the supervisors had a preference for the material for the road and asked if the material excavated from canal can be utilized to use some of that on the road. Mr. Townsend said that we will have to use some of that to fill the existing ditch.

Mr. Townsend and Mr. Giddens asked why the ditch is indicated as having a depth of 6 feet, which is too deep. Ms. Foster said that it can, maybe be a little smaller. After discussion, Ms. Foster said that she presented this drawing for questions and comments, before she presented a final drawing. Ms. Foster said that she will present a final drawing at the next meeting.

6) NEW BUSINESS

a) WATER ANALYSES REPORTS

Ms. Clement said that she has been sending the water analyses to the supervisors and Ms. Foster as she receives them from the laboratory.

The reports were reviewed and Ms. Foster said that she will plot the analyses and present a graph at the next meeting.

7) SUPERVISORS' COMMENTS

None presented.

8) PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Sherrod called for any comments from the public. None presented.
